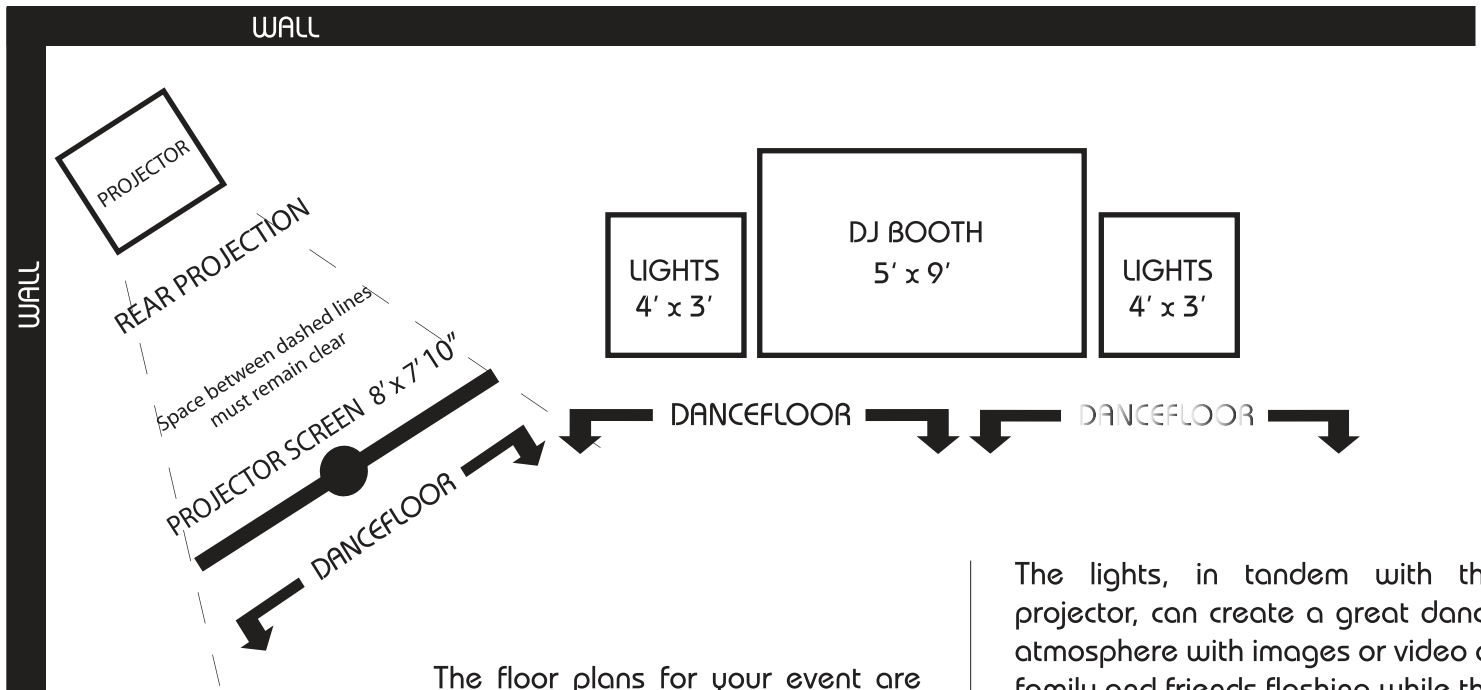


Setting the Stage

booth, lights and projector



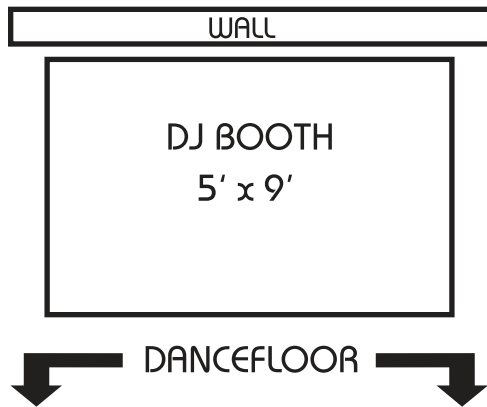
The floor plans for your event are one of the most overlooked aspects in the entire planning process. Let us assist in this important aspect of a successful day.

It is important that the dj production booth be located next to the dance floor and also accessible to the head table where the bride and groom will be seated at the beginning for the meal. On the last page in this packet, there are examples of problematic and ideal setups for your entertainment. Please look them over and consult with us upon choosing an entertainment plan. Proper room design ensures quality sound and will optimize the space available to you. We are available to look at the location before the event to decide how best to set up.

The lights, in tandem with the projector, can create a great dance atmosphere with images or video of family and friends flashing while the light show ensues. If the projector is there for karaoke only, we can display visual effects that coincide with the music when not in use for karaoke.

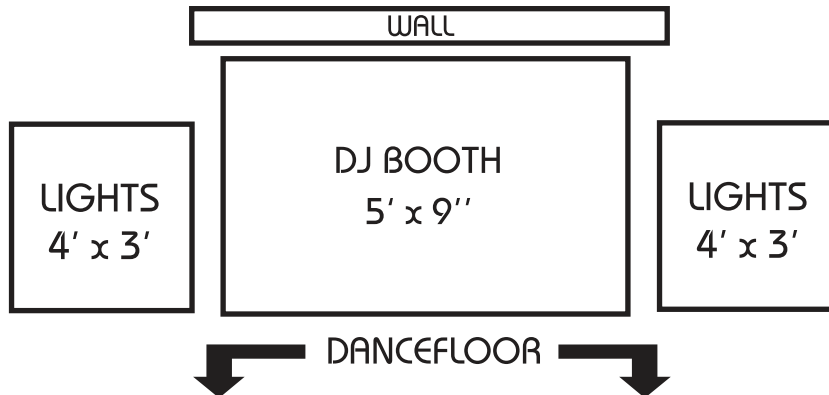
The projector setup is great for karaoke, displaying hi-resolution photos or even playing music videos. It can really set the mood and tempo for the evening by flashing through photos or playing movies of your friends and family attending your event, creating a multi-media environment that gets everyone involved. The screen is roughly 5 feet tall and 6 feet wide. The screen will be set up according to the layout of the room, placed for optimal viewing while maximizing

Basic Setup (music only)



Sometimes space is an issue when setting up for an event. When an event only calls for music and possibly a Master of Ceremonies, our basic setup is used. It is a simple layout and can be set up just about anywhere. Although not shown in the illustration, this 5' by 9' space will fit all of our equipment, including speakers.

Booth and Lighting



This setup is used when a lighting package is purchased. Each box to the left or right of the dj booth contains a number of different lighting boxes but for simplicity in the diagram we drew it all in one box. The approximate distance from one end of the entire setup to the other is 16 ft.

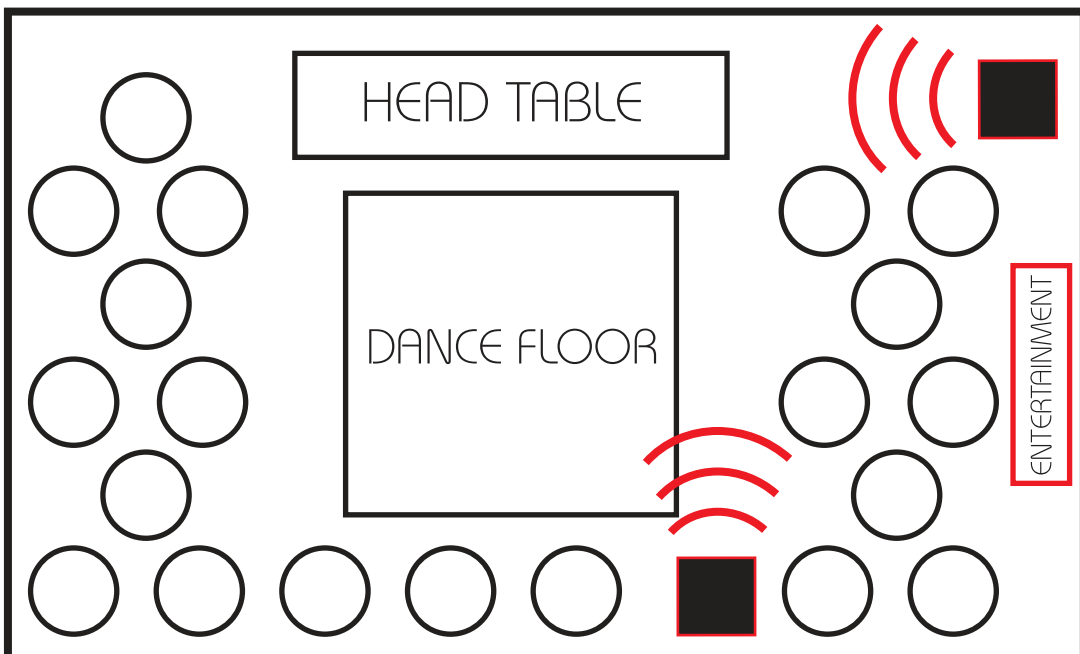
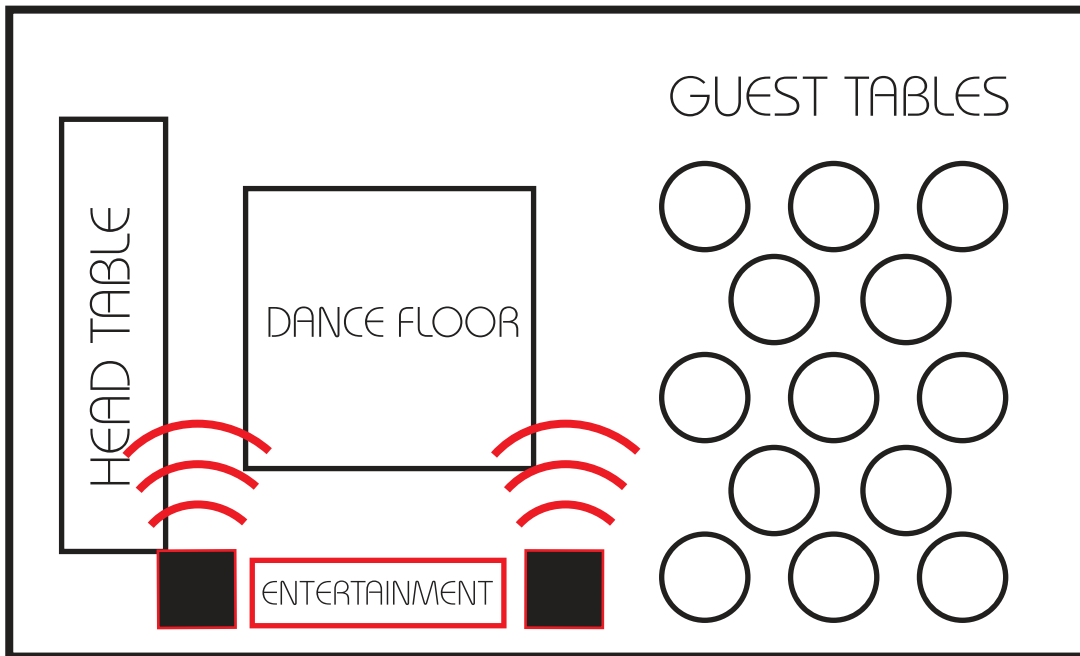
Projector



The frontal projector is generally located on a wall or in a corner but can be located anywhere there is a clear line of sight for ten to fifteen feet. It is good idea to get the rear projector when you are in a tighter reception hall with a larger dance floor. The projector is great for karaoke, videos and photos.

Problematic Setups

These are some examples of layouts that can be problematic because of the sound either not reaching its target area or because the bulk of the sound directly hitting areas such as the guest tables or the head table.



Optimal Setups

These are some examples of layouts that are optimal to deliver sound to its intended area, the dance floor. These are just examples and in order for us to set up our equipment in its most useful way we will need to take a look at the event hall before the day of the event if at all possible. We would also like to have a table layout in order to serve you best.
